In addition, the data includes a summary analysis that includes for each university the 2020 Published List Price, Adjustment from List Price, Average Cost per Journal, and number of Subscribed Titles. This data will be of interest to anyone interested in examining title level pricing from a major commercial publisher.

- **Difference:** Difference between *Published List Price* and *Final Net Price*. Negative values are in parentheses.
- ALP (Adjustment from List Price): Percentage difference between the Published List Price and Final Net Price.
- ACJ (Average Cost per Journal): Average cost paid per journal (USD) based on the Final Net Price and the number of Subscribed Titles

METHODS AND MATERIALS

DATA COLLECTION METHODS

Pricing data was acquired in two ways. For institutions subject to confidentiality restrictions, public records requests were submitted to obtain the relevant pricing information. For Institutions not subject to confidentiality restrictions the pricing information was publicly available.

Information Requested through Public Records Requests

- 2019 and 2020 journal level final prices from the publisher Elsevier.
- 2019 and 2020 journal pricing breakdown that shows how the final price is calculated, including the Content Fee, e-only discount, account price, list price, and any other fees or discounts applied.
- 2019 and 2020 license agreement with the publisher Elsevier.

DATA PROCESSING METHODS

The 2020 published list price was obtained from Elsevier's website. For comparability, journal titles lacking a published list price or a net price from the institutional data were excluded from the analysis. The final net pricing was decreased by the amounts excluded.
